

Clarification and proposed direction on assessment on members for the land purchase. 3/14/18

At the February 14th, 2018 BoD meeting. It was decided by the board to assess every member \$100.00 per year for 3 years for the purchase of the adjoining 27 acres.

Motion by P. Davis seconded by S. Collins "To create a \$100.00 per year assessment on every member for 3 years, with the first payment due on or before Oct 1st. 2018, payments for 2019 and 2020 will be payable with the dues payments."

Motion carried 9 yes 0 no 0 Abstained

(From the meeting minutes of the Board of Directors on February 14th, 2018)

To Clarify:

1. Every member of record on Feb 14th, 2018 is subject to the assessment, including:

- Life members
- Regular members
- Executive members
- New members

2. Honorary members are EXCLUDED from the assessment.

3. New members who join the club after one of the three assessment periods ends are only subject the assessment for the year they join and any subsequent assessment periods. A "New" member is anyone who joins the club who has not previously been a member of the club at any time since 1983.

For example: A new member who joins the club in January of 2019 is only responsible for the 2019 and 2020 payments, and NOT the 2018 assessment.

4. The first payment is due on or before October 1st, 2018 subsequent payments are due as follows:

- 2019 payment due December 1st, 2019 – February 1st, 2020
- 2020 payment is due December 1st, 2020 – February 1st, 2021

5. All new members approved after February 14th, 2018 are subject to the assessment.

There is no pro-ration of the assessment within a given year. The assessment is \$100.00 per year – PERIOD.

6. If any member of record on February 14th, 2018 allows their membership to lapse after February 14th, 2018, they must pay the assessment due for that year's assessment, in addition to any assessment portion that was not previously paid.

In other words, a member cannot intentionally or accidentally allow their membership to lapse, then request to re-join the club after the assessment period has ended, thereby avoiding the assessment, either partially or in full. This provision will expire five years from the date of the adoption of the assessment resolution 2/14/2023

7. Any member who becomes arrears in their assessment payment(s) will have their club privileges and access suspended until they become current in their assessment payment(s). A member in arrears in their assessment will not be allowed to claim the member discount on shooting fees until they become current in their assessment payment(s).

8. Any member requesting a hardship deferment of payment of the assessment must make their request in writing to the board of directors one month prior to the beginning of the assessment period. A member requesting a deferment may be required to show proof of hardship. All requests for deferment will be considered and decided on a case by case basis.
